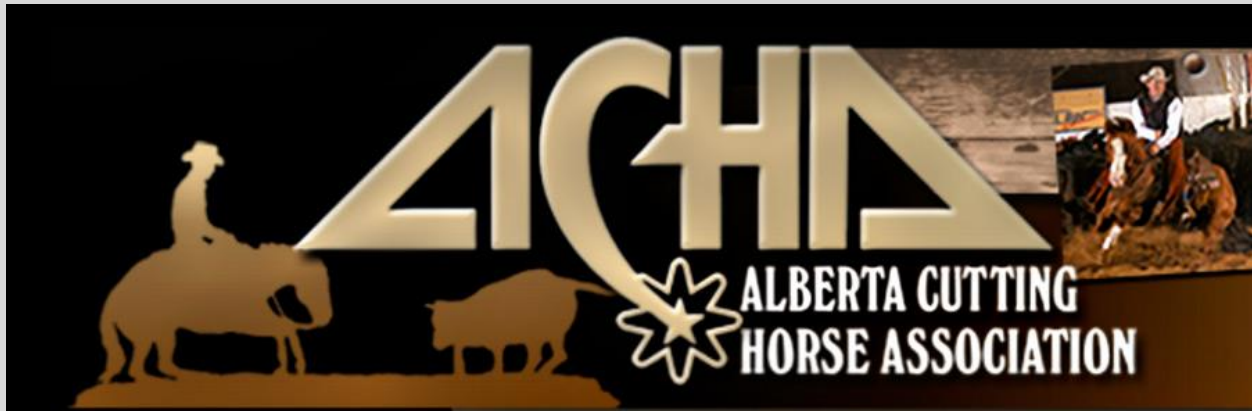


2017 ACHA Showmanship Clinic



Ever wondered why the judge scored you the way he or she did?

Did you have questions following a run?

Want that 70 to become a 73?

Now's your chance!!

Pick from one or two days of ACHA's Showmanship Clinic, designed to help you perfect your run and prepare for the show season. Get one-on-one pointers from AAA-rated NCHA judge as he scrutinizes and marks your run, as well as the feedback from Alberta's top trainers, as they turn back for you and help you dissect your run.

The clinic will be set up in a mock show situation, with each participant completing two runs on fresh cattle per day. Get in-depth feedback from the judge and turn-back help at the completion of each of your two runs PLUS benefit from the analysis of your fellow "competitor's" runs as well. Focus will be on all aspects of showmanship in the run including herd work, picking cattle up the pen, quitting a cow, mental preparedness and putting the polish on a successful run.

Details:

Dates – March 25th and 26th 9am to 4pm daily.

Location – Welland Muri's arena by Madden, AB (West of Crossfield)

Cost - \$650 for two days, \$400 for one day or \$50/day to audit. Payment must be received to reserve your spot. *lunch will be provided each day for participants.
